

## Quick Guide: Getting Around Málaga

Welcome to Málaga! To make your arrival and stay as smooth as possible, here are the best ways to get around the city:

---

### From the Airport (AGP)

The Cercanías C1 train is the fastest and most convenient way to reach the city centre.

- **Station:** Located just outside Terminal 3 (opposite the airport exit)
  - **Frequency:** Every 20–30 minutes
  - **Ticket price:** €1.80 (Zones 1/2)
  - **How to buy:** Tickets can be purchased at the machines at the entrance of the train station
  - **Destination:** Get off at *Málaga Centro Alameda* - approx. a 7-minute walk to NH Málaga

### City Travel & Connections

For navigating the city and checking live schedules, we recommend:

- **Google Maps:** Best for general route planning (bus, metro, and train)
  - **EMT Málaga App:** Official city bus app with real-time arrivals and stop locations (*note: may require a VPN to download/use*)
  - **Moovit:** Very reliable for live updates, delays, and platform changes
- 

### Payment & Transport Cards

Most buses and trains accept contactless payments (Visa and Mastercard, debit or credit cards, as well as mobile payments).

If you plan to use public transport frequently, you may consider these options:

- **EMT Bus Card (Bonobus):**
  - €1.90 for the card + €5 (10 trips)
  - Valid only on Málaga city buses (EMT)
  - Best value for frequent bus use within the city
- **Consortio Card:**
  - €1.50 for the card (top-up from €5 onwards)
  - Valid on buses, metro, and transport across the Málaga province
  - Approx. €0.63 per trip (slightly higher than EMT card but more flexible)

Cards can be purchased at local tobacco shops (*Estancos*).
